

Online Estate Planning FAQ: What Families Need to Know

Simple, Affordable Wills, Trusts, and Advance Directives

How much does it actually cost?

A will starts at \$199 for one person or \$299 for a couple. A trust-based plan (which avoids probate) starts at \$499 individual or \$599 for couples. Both include healthcare directives and powers of attorney. Use code EXCLUSIVE10 at checkout for 10% off any plan.

Is an online will actually legal?

Yes. Trust & Will generates attorney-approved, state-specific documents valid in all 50 states. You complete the questionnaire online, then print and sign with witnesses or a notary per your state's requirements. The documents carry the same legal weight as those prepared by an attorney.

How long does it take to finish?

Most people complete a will in 10 to 20 minutes and a trust in 20 to 30 minutes. You can save your progress and come back anytime. There are no appointments to schedule and nothing to mail in.

Do we need a will or a trust?

A will covers the basics: who gets your assets, who becomes guardian of your children, and who manages your estate. A trust does all of that plus lets your assets skip probate court entirely, which saves your family thousands of dollars and months of waiting. If you own a home or have retirement accounts, a trust is usually worth it.

What if our situation changes later?

You can update your documents anytime through your Trust & Will account. Updates are free for the first 30 days, then \$19 per year for will plans or \$39 per year for trust plans. Your documents stay legally valid even if you cancel the subscription.

What if our estate is complicated?

Trust & Will works best for straightforward estates: a home, retirement accounts, savings, and children who need guardians. If you own a business, have assets over \$1 million needing tax strategies, or have a blended family with complex inheritance wishes, you may need an attorney. Trust & Will is transparent about when their platform is not enough.

What happens if we do nothing?

Without an estate plan, state intestacy laws decide who gets everything. A court appoints your children's guardian. Probate can cost your family \$2,000 to \$6,000 or more and take months to resolve. Every decision gets made by a judge who has never met your family.
