Does the funeral home have to accept this casket?

Yes. Federal law (the FTC Funeral Rule) requires every funeral home in the United States to accept a casket purchased from any outside source. They cannot charge a handling fee or refuse service. This applies to every casket sold by Discount Caskets, including oversized models.

How does the Gemini Gold compare to the Gemini Burgundy?

Both are 18 gauge sealed steel oversized caskets with ivory velvet half couch interiors, available in widths from 29 to 44 inches with capacities up to 750 pounds. The Gold starts at \$1,995 in a champagne gold finish. The Burgundy starts at \$1,895 in a deep wine red finish. Construction, hardware, and delivery are identical. The \$100 difference and color are the only distinctions.

How do I choose the right width for an oversized casket?

Ask your funeral home what shoulder width they have on file for your loved one. The Gemini Series is available in exterior widths from 29 to 44 inches with weight capacities from 300 to 750 pounds. Size up one notch if in doubt. Discount Caskets can also help with sizing questions before you order.

What does 18 gauge sealed steel mean?

18 gauge is the thickness of the steel body. Lower numbers mean thicker metal. At 18 gauge with a rubber gasket seal, this casket sits in the upper range of commercial construction and resists the passage of air, water, and soil elements after burial.

How does this compare to funeral home oversized pricing?

Funeral homes typically charge \$4,000 to \$6,500 for comparable oversized caskets. At a starting price of \$1,995 plus \$299 flat rate delivery, the Gemini Gold can save your family thousands without sacrificing construction quality or weight capacity.
