



What Your Family Needs to Know

Does the funeral home have to accept this casket?

Yes. Federal law (the FTC Funeral Rule) requires every funeral home in the United States to accept a casket purchased from any outside source. They cannot charge a handling fee or refuse service. This applies to every casket sold by Discount Caskets.

How does God Care compare to Going Home?

Both are 18 gauge steel caskets at \$1,695 with blue crepe interiors, swing bar handles, and identical construction. God Care has a gloss sky blue finish that is lighter and more open. Going Home has a deep gloss blue finish closer to navy. Same price, same build, same delivery. The difference is the shade and the presence it carries in the room.

What shade of blue is God Care?

God Care is a gloss sky blue, lighter and more open than Going Home. It carries a faith-forward presence that reads well in brighter sanctuaries, celebration of life services, and rooms with natural light. For a deeper, more traditional blue, compare with Going Home.

How does it ship and when will it arrive?

Discount Caskets ships via commercial airline cargo, wrapped in Styrofoam and bubble wrap inside a protective wooden crate. Orders typically arrive at your funeral home within 1 to 2 business days. Delivery is \$299 flat rate.

How does \$1,695 compare to funeral home pricing?

Funeral homes typically charge \$4,000 to \$6,000 for comparable 18 gauge metal caskets. At \$1,695 plus \$299 flat rate delivery, God Care can save your family \$2,200 to \$4,200 on the same quality of steel construction.
